INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION

To achieve optimal performance and ensure safety, this fixture must be used only with a **low-voltage landscape transformer**. The transformer reduces standard line voltage (120V) down to 12V, making it safe for outdoor landscape lighting applications.

Follow these steps carefully:

Power Off: Turn off electricity at the main switch or breaker before installation begins.

Positioning: Hold the mounting plate against the wall, deck, or step at the desired height and orientation. Use a level to confirm alignment.

Marking Holes: With a pencil or marker, mark the screw hole locations through the pre-drilled slots in the plate.

Drilling Pilot Holes: Choose a drill bit slightly smaller than the screws provided. Drill shallow pilot holes at the marked locations to avoid cracking or weakening the surface.

Creating the Fixture Hole: Mark the opening for the back of the fixture using the plate as a guide. Drill or saw the appropriate hole size. For concrete installations, use an outlet/junction box (not included) designed for this purpose.

Concrete Preparation: When installing in concrete stairs or walls, build conduit raceways before pouring concrete using 1-inch dowels or PVC pipe. Remove the dowels after curing, then finish the riser surfaces.

Securing the Plate: Place the metal plate against the wall or surface, aligning it with the pilot holes. Insert screws and tighten gradually using a screwdriver. Avoid over-tightening to prevent wall damage. Ensure the plate is snug, flush, and level.

Deck and Concrete Installations: For deck mounting, insert the plate carefully into the cut opening. For concrete, secure the fixture to the junction box prepared earlier.

WIRING THE FIXTURE

For safe, waterproof connections, we recommend waterproof wire nuts (sold separately).

Strip Wires: Remove approximately ¾ inch (1.9 cm) of insulation from each wire end. Ensure the exposed metal is clean and not frayed.

Align Wires: Hold the stripped ends of the fixture wire and main cable together, making sure strands do not overlap incorrectly.

Insert and Twist: Place the aligned wire ends into the wire nut, twist clockwise until secure, and verify all bare metal is covered.

Secure Connection: Wrap electrical tape around the wire nut and wires for added protection.

Test: Gently pull on the wires to confirm a solid connection.

CAUTION: Fixtures must comply with all local electrical codes and ordinances. Do not install within 10 feet of pools, spas, or fountains.

ADJUSTING THE LIGHT

After installation, eestore power and confirm the fixture is working.

To change color temperature (CCT), locate the adjustment button on the back of the fixture. Press to select your preferred setting:

- 3000K Warm White
- 4000K Neutral White
- 5000K Cool White

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTION

MOUNTING THE FIXTURE

Align the fixture clips with the slots on the installed metal plate.

Apply firm, even pressure until the fixture locks into place.

Confirm that the fixture is securely seated with no wobble or misalignment.

Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasives that could damage the finish.

Periodically inspect wiring connections for security and integrity.

Proper maintenance will extend fixture performance and lifespan.



FINAL STEPS


Turn power back on at the breaker or switch.
