


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

FIXTURE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Carefully unpack the fixture from the carton.
- 2. Carefully thread one fixture pipe (A), threaded end first, over fixture wires.
- 3. Apply a drop of the supplied thread locking compound to the internal threads of the fixture coupling (B) and screw fix-ture pipe (A) into fixture, being careful not to twist the wires. Note: Application of the thread locking compound is necessary to prevent the stem from loosening during regular maintenance and cleaning of the fixture. Be certain to apply the compound.
- 4. Screw second fixture pipe (A), again using locking com-pound, into fixture coupling (B) other side of fixture without wires.
- 5. See instructions below to complete the installation.



Assemble Canopy Pipes to Ceiling Bracket (Figure 2)


Component Parts

- C Hex Nipple (2)
- Lock Washer (2)
- Ceiling Bracket
- Canopy Pipes (2) F
- Swivel (2)



- Insert threaded end of hex nipple (C) down through lock washer (D), ceiling bracket (E) and into swivel at the end of canopy pipe (F). Note: Ceiling bracket should be oriented with the threaded studs pointing down.
- Tighten hex nipples (C) securely being sure the notches in the swivels are aligned.

CAUTION: FAILURE TO INSTALL THIS FIXTURE PROPERLY MAY RESULT INSERIOUS PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. We recommend installation by a licensed electrician. This product must be installed in accordance with applicable installation code(s), by a person familiar with the construction and operation of the product and the hazards involved.*Caution: Do not exceed maximum wattage noted on fixture. Use only recommended bulbs with fixture.

Assemble Canopy Pipes to Ceiling Bracket (Continued)

Note: If installing on a sloped ceiling, make certain that notches in swivel (P) are oriented toward the lower side of the slope.


Complete Fixture Assembly (Figures 3 & 4)

Component Parts


- **A** Fixture Pipe (2)
- Hex Nipple
- Canopy Pipe (2)
- **H** Canopy
- Plastic Clutch Sleeve (2)
- Set Screw (2)
- G Clutch (2)

CAUTION: BE SURE POWER IS OFF AT THE MAIN BREAKER BOX PRIOR TO INSTALLATION.

- Line up holes in Canopy (H) with fixture pipes (A). Slide over fixture pipes (A) until canopy (H) rests on top of fixture.
- Thread the wires from the fixture pipe (A) into and through the canopy pipe (F) up through the hex nipple (C).
- 3. Unscrew the clutch (G) from the canopy pipe (F); slide it across the wires and onto the fixture pipe (A). Follow this with the plastic clutch sleeve (I), oriented so the tapered end of the clutch sleeve nests in the clutch. Repeat for second set of pipes. (Figure 3).
- 4. Slide the canopy pipe (F) as far as necessary to set desired total length of fixture. Be careful not to scratch the pipe surfaces and to pull excess wire up through the canopy pipe (F). Screw clutch (G) onto canopy pipe (F). There must be a minimum 1-1/2" of inner pipe inside the outer pipe. Handtighten the clutch to temporarily hold this adjustment. The clutch is not securely fastened at this point; do not de-pend on it to hold the fixture. Repeat for both pipes.
 - Important: To ensure full connection strength, be sure the tapered end of the plastic clutch sleeve is oriented toward the clutch when assembled and securely tighten set screw (Figure 3).
- 5. Continue with Ceiling Installation.


L #10 Wood Screws (8)

M Hex Nut

- N Barrel Knobs (2)
- Cupped WasherSafety Cable
- R Threaded Stud (2)
- Using wood screws (L) attach ceiling bracket (E) to a struc-tural member in the ceiling, centering the bracket over the outlet box. Wood screws are supplied with your fixture; however, different materials and/or construction methods may require different fasteners. If in doubt, contact a quali-fied electrician. Do not attach ceiling bracket directly to outlet box.
- Once fixture is fastened to the ceiling and height is properly adjusted, tighten the set screws (J) firmly with hex wrench provided. Be sure to tighten set screws in both clutches (G).
- Raise Canopy (H). Connect Safety Cable (Q) from Canopy to Mounting Bracket (E). Mounting bracket is shipped with a nut on the stud to attach safety cable (Q).
- 4. To wire fixture, route red and blue wires from canopy pipes inward through the oval side slot in Mounting Bracket (E). Blue and red wires on driver are shipped with connectors attached. Connect wires from fixture to connectors on driver, red to red and blue to blue.
- Attach a pigtail lead to the ceiling bracket (E) using cupped washer (O) and hex nut (M). Connect fixture ground wire and pigtail lead to ground wire(s) from electrical box (bare copper or green to bare copper or green).
- 6. Using suitable wire connectors (not provided) connect fixture wires to supply wires (white to white and black to black). Push wires back into outlet box.

CAUTION: MAKE SURE WIRE CONNECTORS ARE TWISTED ON SE-CURELY, AND NO BARE WIRE IS EXPOSED.

- Barrel Knobs (N) are shipped on threaded studs (R). Slide canopy (H) over Mounting Bracket (E) and push firmly to ceiling, making sure that no wires are pinched between fix-ture canopy and ceiling. Screw barrel knobs (N) with studs (R) into standoffs (K).
- 8. Restore electricity at main breaker.
