### WARNING

#### RISK OF FIRE, EXPLOSION AND ELECTRIC SHOCK

- This product should be installed, inspected, and maintained by a qualified electrician only, in accordance with the NEC (National Electric Code) and all local codes.
- Turn off electrical power before inspection, installation or removal.
- Use only UL (or other NRTL) approved wire for input/output connections.
- Make sure LEDs and drivers are cool to touch when performing maintenance. Make sure the supply voltage is the same as the rated voltage of the luminaire.
- Do not install in a hazardous atmosphere, except where the ambient temperature does not exceed the rated operating temperature of the fixture.
- Keep tightly closed when in operation



#### Prepare Electrical Wiring



##### Electrical Requirements

Must check if the local voltage range is correspond with the working voltage of the fixture. Use min. 75°C supply.



##### Grounding Instructions

The grounding and bonding of the overall system shall be done in accordance with NEC Article 600 and local codes.






## PENDANT CABLE INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



Look for the (4) pre-installed grippers on top of the fixture.



Twist top of the pre-installed gripper to loosen the entrance, insert cables, and lock grippers. Adjust to the desired suspension length.



Cut the extra cable in the center once finish adjusting the suspension length.
