

#### 9043 - INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

This Product Must Be Installed in Accordance with the Applicable Installation Code by a Person Familiar with the Construction and Operation of the Product and the Hazards Involved

Installation recommended to be done by a professional electrician and must be in accordance with local codes of the National Electrical Code (NEC)

## **TOOLS REQUIRED FOR INSTALLATION:**

Wire Strippers, Flathead Screwdriver, Philips Screwdriver

# WARNING: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE OR INJURY TO PERSONS:

- 1. To prevent electrical shock, disconnect power supply before servicing.
- 2. Do not touch lens, guard or enclosures. Allow fixture to cool down before servicing.
- 3. Do not operate fixture with missing or damaged parts.

#### INSTALLATION

- 1. To prevent electrical shock, disconnect before installation or service.
- 2. Remove lens cover screws.
- 3. Remove reflector and socket bracket to expose the rear housing.
- 4. Pull wires through housing.
- 5. Connect wires according to color code (White on White, Black on Black).
- 6. Replace reflector and socket bracket.
- 7. Install lamp with correct wattage and type of lamp marked on fixture label.
- 8. Re-install lens cover.
- 9. Reconnect power after servicing.

### LAMP INSTALLATION/ REPLACEMENT:

#### CAUTION: DO NOT EXCEED MAXIMUM WATTAGE MARKED ON FIXTURE LABEL.

- 1. To prevent electrical shock, disconnect power supply before replacing lamp.
- 2. Remove shroud to expose lamp.
- 3. Replace lamp with correct wattage and type of lamp marked on fixture label.
  - NOTE: DO NOT touch Halogen Lamp with bare hands. Always use the plastic bag (if available) or soft cloth when handling the lamp.
- 4. Re-install shroud.
- 5. Reconnect power.
