

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Installation recommended to be done by a professional electrician and must be in accordance with local codes of the National Electrical Code (NEC)

WARNING: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE OR INJURY TO PERSONS:

- 1. To prevent electrical shock, disconnect power supply before servicing.
- 2. Do not touch lens, guard or enclosures. Allow fixture to cool down before servicing.
- 3. Do not operate fixture with missing or damaged parts.

Installation

- 1. To prevent electrical shock, disconnect power supply before installation.
- 2. Remove lens cover screws.
- 3. Pull wires through housing.
- 4. Install and fix housing to suitable wall location.
- 5. Connect wire according to color code (White on White, Black on Black).
- 6. Assure that connections are correct for watertight seal.
- 7. Replace reflector and socket bracket.
- 8. Install lamp with correct wattage and type of lamp marked on fixture label.
- 9. Re-install Lens cover.
- 10. Assure proper placement of Gasket and Lens for watertight seal.
- 11. Reconnect power supply.

LAMPINSTALLATION/ REPLACEMENT: CAUTION: DO NOT EXCEED MAXIMUM WATTAGE MARKED ON FIXTURE LABEL.

- 1. To prevent electrical shock, disconnect power supply before replacing lamp.
- 2. Remove lens cover to expose lamp.
- 3. Replace lamp with correct wattage and type of lamp marked on fixture label.
- 4. Re-install Lens cover.
- 5. Reconnect power.
